#### HELPFUL TIPS TO KNOW WHEN SOWING WESCO SEED:

- 1. Know your soil pH and nutrient status: 6 months before sowing.
- 2. Planting depth is critical to germination and plant survival.
- No more than 15cm deep.
- Small seeds (clover, plantain etc.) max 10mm deep.
- 3. Check soil condition.
- Dry soil, plant seeds slightly deeper; closer to soil moisture.
- Damp soil plant seeds closer to the surface.
- Ensure the seed bed is firm to retain moisture.
- 4. **Application method** is suited to the seed mix and field environment.
- 5. Use a crop diary to record
- Paddocks & crops used
- Planting dates & rates
- Soil moisture, temperature
- Weather
- Application type & settings
- Harvesting/grazing dates.
